Safety Tips

- If you are 12 years old or younger, we highly recommend you build with the help and under the supervision of your parent or guardian.
- Be careful with the hot glue gun – as the name says, the tip and the glue is HOT and can definitely burn you. Please be careful!
- Scissors are sharp and cutting cardboard isn't easy. Take your time and ask for help if you need. Always cut away from you.
